

It is the final day of the 2017 operating system (except for Santa specials over the Christmas period) and Taliesin is the loco in steam. During the first return run there were some issues with the injectors so the loco has rushed up to Boston Lodge works in between trains to see if the issues can be resolved and the loco passed for further duty that day.

Running repairs have been carried out, the loco has been passed to haul the final train of the day (and Season) and this is where the scenario begins.

You will drive to Porthmadog to take water, and collect the train, and then drive a full return journey to Blaenau Ffestiniog before ending the day back at Boston Lodge – timings are based on the actual 13:35PM departure on November 5th, 2017 which was the final service train of the 2017 season.

Please follow all on-screen instructions.

NB. Requires – North Wales Narrow Gauge route freeware available for download from UKTS and the Ffestiniog Stock Pack which is also available from UKTS.

Duration – 145 minutes approx. It is a long scenario which can be saved and resumed at a later time but, to be honest, I feel that it is best enjoyed as a complete return run.

NB. All Red signals should be Tabbed through – you should proceed even if permission is denied. Take care when driving out on the main line, some points will need to be manually set to give you the main line, on the return run you will need to manually set the points for the down line platforms at Tan y Bwlch and Minffordd.
