

The Snowdonian



It is a beautiful Summers day in North Wales and you will be driving the annual special non-stop special excursion train (The Snowdonian) from Caernarfon to Blaenau Ffestiniog – the only stops will be for water at Rhyd Ddu, Minffordd and Tan Y Bwlch.

Please follow all on-screen instructions.

NB. Requires – North Wales Narrow Gauge route freeware available for download from UKTS and the Ffestiniog Stock Pack which is also available from UKTS.

Duration – 188 minutes approx. It is a very long scenario which can be saved and resumed at a later time but, to be honest, I feel that it is best enjoyed as a complete return run.....if you have the staying power 😊

NB. All Red signals should be Tabbed through – you should proceed even if permission is denied.

Check the points as you proceed towards Blaenau Ffestiniog – as you approach each Station ensure that the points are set to allow you into, and out of, the Northbound platforms on the Welsh Highland Railway and the Up platforms on the Ffestiniog Railway.
